NORTH

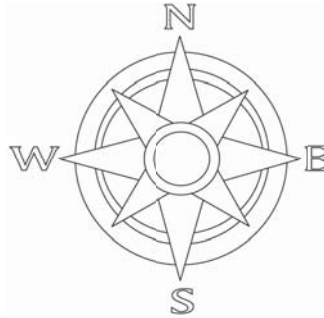
Taking Action
